Change your focus. The \$1 per day per Blog is the starting point, not the goal.

Every blog starts by making a dollar a day or two or whatever. ABS Blogs take time to start making money just like any other blog. The software just makes it possible to build more blogs faster. You earn more money for 50 than 2 but per blog is the same.

Now you have 50 times more work to do. Software does not do the work for you, it helps you by making it easier, faster and more accurate. If you use automated software properly, Google has no problem with it. Most of the garbage automatically generated does not even get indexed because Google knows the difference.

The \$1 per blog means that you've done it right, it's indexed, it's getting traffic and making a few sales. The software doesn't make that happen, you do.

Start with what nobody talks about - the small stuff that makes a difference. If you can't handle the small stuff, then chances are Google won't expect your site to have the big stuff done right either.

#1 Make sure you have a unique title tag on every page or search engines think the subject of all your pages is the same and they won't be indexed at all.

#2 Make sure title tags are unique by going to all the major search engines to see if anyone is using the same one you think is unique. That's where the age of the domain matters. Guess which site is going to be "unique" in Google's eyes?

#3 Domains 9+ years old can get away with anything - even very little content They just need back links to get ranked PR3 or better. If you want to age your domain faster than everyone else, let them renew for 1 year while you renew for 10 if you can afford it.

Ready-made sites are great if you fix them but how many people do? That's why they want it done for them - but 12 sites for \$17 or whatever is a waste of money. Anything you don't build yourself, won't work properly until you fix it.

These guys selling those cheap sites all day long are cutting out their competition not helping anyone. If you knew the names of some of them, you would be shocked but it would make sense. That's why they make so much money and keep helping so many, and suddenly they disappear.

They "retire" because someone decided to say something loud enough to be heard. Google shut down how many adsense sites? Big name accounts deleted for no reason? Okay.

#4 Your title tag should have keywords at the beginning - no more than 70 characters are indexed anyway.

#5 Meta Descriptions show up with the Title Tag and they are as important now as they were 10 years ago. Again, competition was the reason for meta tags being unnecessary. That is the advertisement for your site that tells search engines where your site should be ranked.

What happens if the meta-description is missing? Does Google send you a letter and tell you? NO, you have to follow their instructions by looking up information and reading it. Listening to some joker lie about the 6 figure income you can make, just so he can barely earn 4 figures is crazy.

You know exactly who they are too. Most, not all but most of them are the ones you've bought products from that do nothing but send you emails to sell you more products. They never have a forum like this either. Divide and conquer is the way they keep selling the same garbage over and over.

Why does everyone use adsense? Those are the ugly ads that pay you when they show up on your blog, right? Or, do you get paid only when someone clicks on them? Wouldn't you make more money by putting actual products that people buy on your site? The easiest way to get some real wholesale products that you don't have to qualify to sell or pay anything to set up is:

That storefront is real but its geared towards mainstream business and that's why its completely free. You can customize the About Me page and add a logo at the top on the left but that's about it. Look where they have the promotional banners and links. Pick any product you want to sell, enter the stock number and then copy the code it gives you into on of the html source code add-on boxes or whatever they are called.

You can do the same thing with Amazon. If you want some back links and other promotions done, you can go to www.fiverr.com and pay \$5.00 for whatever you want. Next time and every time after someone calls you for something, return the favor and ask whoever wants something to go log into your blog and make a comment, go tweet your blog, digg, bookmark it. If they don't have the skills or the time, then \$5 will handle it.

Another quick but high PR - I think it was an 8 last time I checked is www.Bravenet.net Go create a FREE account put your URL in the profile and then use some of the tools if you want. It's all free unless you upgrade. Get a free ad here: www.trafficcentral.net Go visit Jim's Place where everything is free.

Metatags and description are automatically filled in your blogs and it is easier with a blog rather than static pages. Only in static HTML pages you gotta fill those meta info but with blogs, most of the stuff is automated and easy indeed!

Adsense is better because it works with sites even with minimal traffic. You get paid only when someone clicks on your ad. You sure can try direct selling on your blog for additional revenue, but nobody buys anything the first time they visit your blog. Adsense is best on these fly by the night type of visitors.

Some of your blogs are gonna get traffic and some aren't. Some of my blogs are doing really well, and some are doing nothing.

However, on AVERAGE, I'm doing okay.

Secondly, you need a plan. How are you picking the topics for your autoblogs?

Picking the right topics will increase your percentage of successful blogs.

Check my signature link for a concise, easy to follow plan.

If a couple of your blogs start getting traction in the search engines and earning some money, put more effort into them.

Build upon the success by doing things like adding some unique content, or pointing some text anchored

links at your site.

You could also build a couple of blogs on topics closely related to your more successful blogs, and leverage your success.

You shouldn't have to do anything "daily to set up blogs for the next day or the next week". That kinda defeats the purpose for using ABS to automate things as much as possible.

Once you have a site set up to post at the right frequency (I have most of mine set to post a maximum twice per day), and the content sources (RSS feeds, articles etc) setup then you don't have to do anything every day.

I open my ABS once per week and select "Update All Feeds" and go do something else.

Then I come back and run through all the downloaded posts, deleting anything off-topic, editing some post titles and randomly checking some post content to make sure everything worked okay.

Then I select all the posts and hit "Post To Blog" and go do something else.

Once all the posts have been made I select all the posts, delete them all and I'm done for the week.

Takes me 1-2 hours absolute max.

Otherwise, you are right, you should be spending most of your time researching topics and setting up new blogs.

Trying to do this auto blogging stuff with free website hosts like blogger is false economy. If you value your time at all you MUST have your own hosting account and have control of your websites.

Hostgator allows you to have unlimited domains for only \$9.95 per month.

A domain name only costs about \$10 per year. Most of your sites should at a bare minimum cover their domain name cost after a year.

The other thing about WordPress (that I'm only just getting into) is that with one hosting account and one installation of WordPress 3.0, you can now host multiple blogs all under the one installation - just like owning your own Blogger :blink:

I've put up 4 new blogs just this last week. And all of those blogs can be controlled and updated from one master administration panel. Each blog can have its own web address. B)

Take a look: The Franco Files is the main installation and Health Labyrinth is a new blog hosted under, and managed from, the admin panel at Franco Files. ;)

There are a few major changes to the algorithms Google uses that have already been put into effect. Nobody wants to hear them but hiding won't make them go away.

Without going into ugly details - why not just do what common sense dictates. That's the gist of the

Google PR and how your site is ranked now. SIZE doesn't matter. It's what you do with your pages that does matter.

Contextual links matter - a lot. BUT only within the content and only if the page is linked to the HOME page. NO paid links other than privately negotiated between owners or webmasters and more than 50 Top QualityLinks won't matter much anymore. LINKBuilding is OVER. Gutter links and navigational links are ignored too. Linking between your own blogs works. Try linking to WIKI for a reference within the content. Or, any top ranking site that has relevant helpful information.

Remember, you heard it here first! I love automation. I've been automating tasks for nearly 30 years, way back when one key punch card was equal to 1line of code (LOC) and all we had was FORTRAN, COBOL, RPG II and BASIC. It wasn't fun but I loved automation more than I hated programming.

Carty makes programming fun again with automation that doesn't cross the line into degradation without help from the user. Therin lies the problem. Google knows what automated software is and they know when it's used properly and when it's not. LSI and AI Software has been used more in the last 2 years as they try and reduce the lines of code it takes for machines to understand simple commands but they can't.

Millions and millions of lines of code is too much and not enough at the same time. Human Intelligence will never be duplicated and that's why loopholes exist and hackers find ways to crack the code. Whenever you get something for nothing, someone else gets nothing for something.

Nobody can change what is. Work with it, not against it or nobody wins. Good has to outweigh bad or it's garbage according to the robots. Automate the worst, most time-consuming part of creating and maintaining each blog and make sure humans do the rest. Who doesn't matter as long as they are people.

Working with other people works. I don't do dishes, ever. But if I'm at a friends house and the dishes need to be washed and dried, I'll do them without thinking twice. It's more fun doing someone elses work than it is your own. Here's why:

Without even knowing it, you will do a better job, enjoy it, add your twist of personality and then look forward to being thanked and complimented on the great job you did. That means both of you are getting better results and money is a result. It's never the reason. You have to show results before money will appear.

The key to not getting banned is to pay \$10 per month for hosting, and \$10 per domain name for your sites.

Real pictures taken from your own camera and uploaded count higher than stock photos - think Home Made like Grandma. Did you know you can go to fiverr and pay \$5 for someone to call your mother/grandmother and talk to her for 30 minutes - just chit-chat on the phone.

Going back to the original question (havent been here for a while) one of my niche subdomains made £8.15 the other day. Thats one subdomain. So lets do some calculations,

I have one main site and 11 sub-domains. So..lets say each site makes half of the above figure..

So £4.07 multiply by 11 = £44.77

44.77 multiply by 7 (days a week) = £339.39 per week

A YEAR?

£339.39 multiply by 52 (weeks a year) =

£16,296

Not bad eh? not all sites will make that a day, but hey when I am receiving on average £1.85 a click that yearly figure is not impossible.
